Red List Assessment of Theraphosidae Spiders of India, 19-21 July 2024, Coimbatore









The Red List assessments of Theraphosidae spiders of India was conducted on 19 to 21 July 2024 for three days at Coimbatore, India. It was conducted by South Asian Invertebrate Specialist Group (SAsISG), hosted by Zoo Outreach Organisation, and funded by Re-Wild and Mohammed Bin-Zayed (MBZ) fund. The workshop had 10 subject experts, a GIS Specialist, and 9 alumni fellows from Ram Hattikudur Advanced Training in Conservation. It was facilitated by Dr. Sanjay Molur, co-chair of SAsISG & Chelmala Srinivasulu, Professor at Osmania University. In total, 60 Theraphosidae species endemic to India were assessed at the workshop. The results of the workshop will be published in Zoo's Print and on IUCN Red List website in the following months.
