Wildlife (Protection) Amendment Act, 1987
 No. 48 of 1987, Section 32

Prohibition of Feeding etc. in a Zoo
 No person shall tease, injure, molest, or feed any animal or otherwise, or offer the grounds to a child.

B for Bears too...

There are 8 kinds of bears in the world. Four kinds are found in India and other South Asian countries. They are Himalayan Black Bear, Red Bear and Sloth Bear. Bears belong to a group of animals that scientists call a "family" - the "family" of bears is a "tribe" - named the Ursidae (to be sure, that's Bears from Latin word for bear, and Bears have been around for a long time - 20-30 million years).

Bears are very intelligent animals with a brain some of which is in their stomachs. Bears are omnivores, meaning they eat both plants and animals. They are also very curious and will investigate anything that is new to them. They are also very shy and will usually only come out when they are hungry.
